Jerez de la Frontera, well known for its sherry wine, its horses and its flamenco, preserves a historic centre that has been declared a historic artistic site. You will learn the process of elaborating and aging sherry wine while visiting one of the top sherry wine producers: Lustau Winery. Out of over 9000 entries in the International Wine Challenge, Lustau alone won 4 Gold, 11 Silver and 6 Bronze medals and 17 Seals of Approval. This represents four times as many as any other sherry house. At the end of the visit you will taste some Spanish tapas, including Spanish omelette and ham, and tasting some of the wines produced at the winery.
