Since 2003 the city of Pablo Picasso’s birth becomes home to the **Museo Picasso** Málaga—a new museum devoted to the most influential artist of the twentieth century. The museum's collection includes works from the private collections of Christine Ruiz-Picasso and Bernard Ruiz-Picasso as part of the permanent collection.
