Depart from Paris for the discovery of two emblematic towns of Normandy: Honfleur, inspiration for impressionist painters with its lovely old houses and the wooden church tower Sainte-Catherine and Etretat, the visual beauty of which has been so well depicted over the years by poets, painters and writers.

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From Paris to Normandy

7.00 am: Meet your driver-guide in the lobby of your hotel in Paris and drive to Normandy.

Visit Honfleur with its Old Dock, the most symbolic place in the city with the very typical high houses. The Old Dock is a tremendous foreground for painters, among them famous impressionists such as Claude Monet and Eugène Boudin.

Here you can visit the **Eugène Boudin Museum**, founded in 1868. The gallery exhibits the works of the landscape painters of 19th and 20th century Honfleur.

You may wish to enjoy lunch at the **Michelin starred Ferme Saint-Siméon**, a refined restaurant with a terrace looking out onto the sea. Do not miss the fine selection of calvados and good, classic cuisine!

Continue your trip and visit Etretat. Etretat is best known for its **cliffs, including a famous natural arch.** These cliffs and the associated resort beach attracted artists such as Eugène Boudin, Gustave Courbet and Claude Monet.

In Etretat you may wish to visit **The Chapel of Notre Dame de la Garde**, built in 1854 in homage to sailors and destroyed in World War II. It was rebuilt in 1950.

Depending on your own schedule you can visit **the Benedictine Palace**, 15 km from Etretat in Fécamp, a town steeped in art and history.

The Bénédictine Palace, with its unusual Gothic-Renaissance architecture, is an open invitation to the discovery of a historic tale and a product. It is here that the Bénédictine liqueur is produced. The Palace is an art museum, a distillery and a contemporary art gallery.

Return to Paris at the end of the afternoon.

Visit the château d'Harcourt, which is a beautiful specimen of the some of the best preserved Medieval military architecture in France. Harcourt has preserved its strengthened enclosure overhanging of impressive ditches, its farmyard, its châtelet and its high home seigniorial arranged "with modern" at the end of the 17th century. Harcourt is enchased today in a famous arboretum of a thousand of rare species.
